



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of 30 October 2020, No. 1111

on the amendment of the crisis measure declared under No. 432/2020 Coll.

In relation to Government Resolution No. 957 of 30 September 2020, whereby the Government, in line with Articles 5 and 6 of Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on the Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the Czech Republic, due to a threat to health in relation to the documented occurrence of a coronavirus (designated as SARS CoV-2) in the Czech Republic, and in line with Section 5(a) to (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Crisis Management and amending certain acts (the Crisis Act), as amended, to address the current emergency situation, the Government has decided to adopt emergency measures, pursuant to Section 5(e) and Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act.

Effective from 12:00 a.m. of 31 October 2020, the **Government**

amends Government Resolution No. 1103 of 26 October 2020, promulgated under No. 432/2020 Coll., as follows:

1. in I/1, bullet points are added after the last bullet point, worded:
 - “- establishments engaged in processing stone (e.g. the manufacture of memorials, gravestones and their installation),
 - establishments (including mobile) selling mourning goods, e.g. wreathes, floral arrangements for graves, mourning candles and similar; the prohibition of sale in mobile facilities does not apply to these establishments listed in point I/7,”;
2. in point I/8, the semi-colon at the end is replaced with a comma and letter f) is added, worded:
 - “f) establishments (including mobile) selling mourning goods, e.g. wreathes, floral arrangements for graves, mourning candles, etc., if the sale is conducted on Sunday between 05:00 a.m. and 7:59 p.m.”.
