



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of 7 January 2021 No. 12

on the Amendment of Emergency Measures

In connection with Government Resolution No. 957 of 30 September 2020, under which the Government, pursuant to Articles 5 and 6 of Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on the Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency in the Czech Republic due to the threat to health in connection with the documented occurrence of the coronavirus (known as SARS CoV-2) in the territory of the Czech Republic and within the meaning of Section 5(a) through (e) and Section 6 of Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Crisis Management and on the amendment of certain acts (the Crisis Act), as amended, in order to deal with the arising crisis, it has decided to adopt crisis measures, within the meaning of Section 5(b) through (e) and Section 6(1)(b) of the Crisis Act.

Effective from 12:00 a.m. on 11 January 2021, the **Government**

amends the period of effectiveness of:

1. Government Resolution No. 1375 of 23 December 2020, promulgated under No. 595/2020 Coll.,
2. Government Resolution No. 1376 of 23 December 2020, promulgated under No. 596/2020 Coll.,
3. Government Resolution No. 1378 of 23 December 2020, promulgated under No. 598/2020 Coll.,
4. Government Resolution No. 1379 of 23 December 2020, promulgated under No. 599/2020 Coll., in that its effectiveness is extended until 11:59 p.m. of 22 January 2021.
