In accordance with a mutual desire to promote international research, scientific and advanced educational exchange, Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NTU) and the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague (UCT Prague), have agreed to cooperate within the framework of the principles mentioned below.

I.

Scientific and research cooperation shall be undertaken in the area of automotive related technologies, including autonomous vehicles, electric vehicles, and energy storage materials and technologies. Such cooperation will be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual advantage.

II.

The cooperation between NTU and UCT Prague will be implemented in the following ways:

- Research collaboration;
- Exchange of academic staff, researchers and students mainly for research projects;
- Organisation of bilateral joint symposiums, seminars, and conferences.

III.

Each institution shall ensure, in compliance with its respective laws and regulations, the assistance and support for scholars who are temporarily residing on its territory, under the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding ("Memorandum").

IV.

This Memorandum does not result in any financial obligations. Each institution will be responsible for seeking funds to support its involvement in the cooperative activities contemplated under this Memorandum, and all such activities will be dependent upon the budgetary appropriations of the institutions.

V.

The terms of cooperation for each activity implemented under this Memorandum shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both institutions prior to the initiation of

that activity. Any such agreement entered into, as outlined above, will form an Appendix to this Memorandum.

VI.

All academics, researchers and/or students of an institution participating in research at the other institution ("host institution") are required to have a valid health insurance policy covering all medical expenses and a valid insurance covering property damage caused to the host institution for the territory of the host country over the entire period of their stay at the host institution.

Participants have to fulfill all the conditions required by the immigration authority of the host country.

VII.

This Memorandum is prepared in English in two copies.

VIII.

This Memorandum is valid for five (5) years from the day it was signed. Each institution has a right to suggest amendments to this Memorandum. Any amendments are valid when made in written form and numbered and confirmed by both institutions.

This Memorandum can be terminated by either institution subject to notice in written form to be received by the other institution no less than three (3) months before the expiration of this Memorandum.

IX.

No public disclosure, advertisement or any other form of publicity by either institution relating to this Memorandum or the subject matter herein, except for internal announcements or mandatory disclosures required to meet legal or regulatory requirements, shall be made without the prior written approval of the authorised representative of the other institution.
